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### **Welcome Comment**

Good morning Language Class. It's Monday again and the start of another new week! Here are your activities for today.

Don't forget to keep in touch and email me photos or videos of your activities. I love to see them. If you have any problems or questions please email me on the MLU address and I will respond to you as soon as I can.

**English Task** Please practise your phonics daily with Read Write Inc reading and spelling sessions on You Tube. Please try reading for 10-20 minutes each day. I am watching [www.getepic.com](http://www.getepic.com) carefully to see how many books you are reading on this website!

We are going to be thinking about the story 'Shark in the Park' again this week. Watch <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=nWRwBRVeGQs> as a reminder of the story. This week you are going to create your own book based on 'Shark in the Park' using some of the rhyming words you generated last week. Today you need to decide on an animal (character) and a place (setting) for your story. For example instead of 'Shark in the Park' you may use 'Goat on a Boat' or 'Mouse in a House' etc. You could use your ideas from last Thursday's activities to help. Design a front cover including title and picture. Use [www.nicksharratt.com](http://www.nicksharratt.com) for some of Nick Sharratt's drawing tips.

**Maths Task** Everyone start by playing 'Hit the Button'. <https://www.topmarks.co.uk/maths-games/hit-the-button>. YR/Y1 choose 'Number Bonds' and then 'Make 10 or addition to 10'. Y2's please choose 'timestables'.

This week we are looking at fractions. **YR/ Y1** remind a grown up of the meaning of 'whole' (all of it) and 'half' (split into 2 equal parts). Can you find things around your home and during the day that are whole or half? Can you split things in half? (e.g. sandwiches/ packet of biscuits/ playdoh etc). **Y2/Y4's** we have previously learnt lots about fractions of shapes and objects and this week we are focusing on fractions of **quantities**. <https://whiterosemaths.com/homelearning/year-2/> Week 1, lesson 3 - Find a half. Watch and complete the videoclip activities as a reminder to how to find half of a quantity and complete the linked worksheet activity 'Find Half of a Quantity'.

**Foundation Subject Task** Miss D has set a family 'Reading Challenge' for you today. Your challenge is to create a reading den. Reading dens are special spaces to curl up with a book. They don't need to be permanent – in fact, temporary dens, built from household objects are best! There are loads of different ways to make one. You could use a rug, sheet or even a pile of cushions to create a cubbyhole in an unexpected place. You could turn a huge cardboard box into a reading castle, or drape a rug or sheet over a washing line to create a reading tent. Small children can even snuggle up under an umbrella on a rug. To turn a den into a *reading* den, just add cushions, blankets... and books! You might create some reading inspired art work to add a finishing touch. When it is finished, sit down to read one or two books together as a reward for your hard work. Don't forget to send over your photos and we will choose some of the best ones to put on the school website. Happy den building!
