English Task

Today we would like you to practise your phonic skills. Try 'Activity 1' from this lesson on BBC the BBC Bitesize website. (Dated 18th May)

Alternatively, on a piece of paper, write the following graphemes. Remember, a grapheme is a letter, or group of letters that represent a sound.

ee as in green, ie as in pie, ea as in tea, ir as in bird and aw as in claw. Using these graphemes as labels, see how many items you can find around your home that contain each grapheme. Try and find one item per grapheme.

Maths Task

Then make some of your own number cards. For example, 40-60. (You can make it easier or as hard as you want). Shuffle the cards and reveal one. Do you think the next number will be more or less?

Foundation Subject Task

Mrs Digger has set a family Geography challenge for you today. Your challenge is to create a 'Map' of your daily walk. Think about where you go on your daily walk. Which landmarks will you see along your journey, maybe a school, church, friend's house, can you draw these landmarks? If you are not leaving your house at the moment, or do not have a garden of your own, it could be that you choose to draw a map of the inside of your house, maybe from your bedroom to the kitchen. Can you draw a pathway of what you see along your route, do you have to go down the stairs, past the front door? Email a picture of your map and your name to your class email address.
