Good morning Language Class. Here are your activities for today.

English Task Please practise your phonics daily with Read Write Inc reading and spelling sessions on You Tube. Please try reading for 10-20 minutes each day. Let me know which book you are reading.

Today I would like you to create the middle of your story for your book about Timothy Pope. Use the model of 'Shark in the Park' but change it to use your own character (animal) and setting (place) you chose on Monday. Start by saying then writing the middle of the story with your ideas using the attached worksheet (next pages 5-7). Y2's you can write it out completely (think about your letter formation and handwriting please!) YR/Y1 you can print out the worksheet and add the missing words. You can add pictures and colour to make your pages of your book exciting! Use your ideas from last Friday's activities to help complete page 7.

Maths Task

Everyone start again by playing 'Hit the Button'. <https://www.topmarks.co.uk/maths-games/hit-the-button>. YR/Y1 choose 'Number Bonds' and then 'Make 10 or addition to 10'. Y2's choose 'timestables'. Try a different timestable today.

YR/ Y1 can you practice writing your numbers today please? Can you write numbers 20-80 starting at 20 and counting back. Then ask a grown up to challenge you to write any 2-digit number they give you e.g. 35, 81 etc.

Y2/Y4's use <https://whiterosemaths.com/homelearning/year-2/> Week 2, lesson 1 - Recognise a third. Watch and complete the videoclip activities as a reminder to how to find third of a quantity/ shape and complete the worksheet activity on this website 'Recognise a third'.

Foundation Subject Task

Today I would like you to continue being scientists and think about space and our solar system. Can you draw the different planets? Find out a few more facts on one of the planets.
