English Task Please practise your phonics daily with Read Write Inc reading and spelling sessions on You Tube. Please try reading for 10-20 minutes each day. Let me know which book you are reading.

Y2's you can write it out completely (think about your letter formation and handwriting please!) YR/Y1 you can print out the worksheet and add the missing words. You can add pictures and colour to make your pages of your book exciting! Use your ideas from last Friday's activities to help complete page 10. Please send me a photo of your books or a video of you reading your book. Go for it!

Maths Task

Everyone start again by playing 'Hit the Button'. <https://www.topmarks.co.uk/maths-games/hit-the-button>. YR/Y1 choose 'Number Bonds' and then 'Make 10 or addition to 10'. Y2's choose 'timestables'. Try a different timestable today.

YR/ Y1 can you practice writing your numbers again today please? Can you write numbers 0-20 starting at 0 and counting on in 2's! Then ask a grown up to challenge you to write any 2-digit number they give you e.g. 35, 81 etc.
