**English Task** Please practise your phonics daily with Read Write Inc reading and spelling sessions on You Tube. You should be practising your set 3 sounds. Please try reading for 10-20 minutes each day. Have you learnt the next 5 spellings on your list?

We are thinking about the story 'Shark in the Park on a Windy Day' this week. This is another picture book by the author and illustrator Nick Sharratt. Today we are going to start by listening to Nick Sharratt read his story by watching the following videoclip. <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=R2RwvAHUAdc>. Talk with a grownup about the setting (where?) for the story and the different characters in the story (who?) How is this the same as 'Shark in the Park'? and how is it different? How many rhyming words can you identify in the story? Write down as many as you can. You may also want to learn more about the author on his website at [www.nicksharratt.com](http://www.nicksharratt.com) and play some of the games or following more of his drawing tips. I enjoyed drawing Mr Pope, a shark and a dinosaur!

### Maths Task

Everyone start by playing 'Place Value Basketball'. Challenge yourself and play a harder level than when we first played this game a few months ago.
