Read the story together and talk about the places the pirates go. Can you explain some of the words in the story; hoard, torn, wreck, fear.


Then have a go at writing some words that rhyme with;

Maths Task

Today we would like you to think about number sentences. Use your counters or any small objects like coins and count out 20. (Try counting them in 2s as this is a quicker way of counting objects!) This is your treasure!

1. You have 20 pieces of treasure and a pirate stole 4. How much do you have left?
Use the counters to work it out and then record your number sentence; $20-4=16$
2. You have 20 pieces of treasure and a pirate stole 9. How much do you have left?
Remember to record your sentence.

You can repeat this as many times as you would like by taking away other numbers. As an extra challenge you could have a go at working out the number family, for example $20-4=16$ so $16+4=20$.

Foundation Subject Task

Today we have set a family Design and Technology challenge. As we are seeing so many rainbows around at the moment, we thought we'd use the symbol of hope for our DT family challenge.

We would like you to have a go at creating your own Rainbow themed food. You could use a rainbow of fruits or vegetables or a selection of coloured treats!
