English Task

Please practise your phonics daily with Read Write Inc reading and spelling sessions on You Tube. You should be practising your set 3 sounds. Please try reading for 10-20 minutes each day. Have you learnt the next 5 spellings on your list?

In 'Shark in the Park on a Windy Day' Timothy Pope goes to the park with his favourite toy – his telescope. What is your favourite toy? Talk about this with a grown up. Describe your toy. What does it look like? What does it feel like? What do you do with it? Where do you keep it? Why is it your favourite? Etc. Then write about it BUT don't say what it is. Send me your description and I will see if I can guess what it is! Think about your handwriting and spelling when you are writing today too!

Maths Task

Foundation Subject Task

Today I would like you to do some P.E. I would like you to try the Virtual School Games challenge 'Catch it Challenge' this week. It is a test of your throwing and catching skills! It will also test your concentration and reaction skills. All you need to complete the challenge is a ball (but a pair of rolled up socks will also work) The object is to bounce and catch the ball as many times as you can! Bounce a ball on the floor and then catch it - how many can you catch in 60 seconds? (the ball can bounce once or twice).
