English Task

Today we would like you to start writing a wanted poster for a pirate. Take a look at the picture of a pirate and for today think of words that best describe him (adjectives). It is a good idea to start at the top and work your way down. This way you have included everything. You could also think of a pirate name for him! Write down the adjectives you would like to use ready for tomorrow.
 E.g. Black hat, yellow skull and cross bone, scary eye, round eyepatch....



Maths Task

Today we would like you to use your pirate treasure again. A group of pirates have found a magical treasure chest. Every time you put coins into it, the magical treasure chest doubles the amount of coins!

1. What do you think will happen if you put 4 coins into the chest?
2. What will happen if you put 5 or 10 coins into the chest?
3. Repeat with other numbers.



Foundation Subject Task

Today we would you to start to make a treasure map. If you would like to make your map look old you could use a plain piece of paper and use a teabag to stain the paper then leave it to dry before you start. On your map you must include these physical features; mountains, beach, forest, lake, river and mark the treasure with an X.
