
English Task

Yesterday, you drew a picture of where the story was set in 'Sharing a Shell'. Today we would like you to write some describing words to go onto your picture. For example, you might write – bloo wortur or big rok. Think about the colours, size and also what things might sounds like.



Maths Task

Today we need your help! Someone has been selling number bond ice-creams on the beach, but they have got all in a muddle! Can you cut them out and help stick them back together? You can use the counters in your resource pack to help you do this. You will need 10 counters.



- First cut out an ice-cream or cone and look at the number on it, for example **5**.
- From your 10 counters, **count out 5 counters**.
- Then, count how many counters you have left, **you have 5 left**.
- You can then find the ice-cream with the 5 on it and stick them back together!

Do you think you can match all the ice-creams to the right cones?

Foundation Subject Task

The creatures that live under the sea move very differently to how we do on land. We would like you to listen to this music and make up your own 'Under the Sea' dance! Can you move like some of the creature in the story? Have fun!
