English Task

Yesterday you wrote down words to describe the setting in our story 'Sharing a Shell'. Today we would like you to write a sentence using those words. For example, if you wrote – slimee seaweed and on your picture you could write the sentence 'The slime seaweed was in the bloo rokpool.'
Remember to use your finger spaces and a full stop in your writing.

Maths Task

Today we are going to continue learning number bonds to 10. For today's activity you will need the dice from your home learning resource pack, as well as 10 counters. We are going to be writing number bonds in a number sentence!

- Roll the dice and write down that number on your white board, for example **6**. Then count out 6 counters from the 10 you have out.
- Next look at how many counters you have left after counting out 6. You have **4** left!
- Write down the rest of your number sentence, so you would write **6 + 4 = 10**.
- Roll your dice again and see if you can write another number bond number sentence.

Foundation Subject Task

Today we are going to think about our feelings and what makes us happy. Can you tell someone what makes you feel happy? It might be when you get to do something like play football, or see someone or even eat your favourite food! Draw a picture of all the things that make you happy.
