Today we would like to revisit **counting on** in different steps. Using your whiteboards. Can you start at the number 13 and write the next 10 numbers?

Now start at the number 8. Can you count on in 2s? How far can you get?

Start at 30 and count on in 10s, write down these numbers.

Finally start at 5 and count in 5s.

As an extra challenge, get somebody to rub out some numbers, then try to guess which numbers are missing in your pattern.
