



 Here are your tasks for today.
 We hope you have tried out the Worcestershire Virtual School Games challenge this week!
 Have fun!

English Task

After listening to/ reading the story 'The Snail and the Whale' by Julia Donaldson
 We would like you to imagine you are the snail and you are writing a postcard back to your friends back at the harbour.
 Today select a picture of a place from the story. As you draw the picture talk about what you can see.
 For example; the sea is as cold as ice. (This is a **simile** because it compares one thing with another)
 You could try out other similes e.g. the icebergs as tall as mountains. (We have attached a template of a postcard for you to use).



Maths Task

Today we would like you to start by practising halving numbers try out this game and see how quickly you can them work out! <https://www.topmarks.co.uk/maths-games/hit-the-button>
 After this we can you look again at **capacity**. First find a large container (like a plastic bowl or bucket. Then find a smaller cup. Can you predict how many cups of water will fill up the larger container? Write down your predictions and then use the cup to fill up the larger container. Was your prediction accurate?

Foundation Subject Task

Today we would like you to learn about animals that live in a coral reef. Watch this clip to find out which animals live in amongst the coral.
