Good Morning Year 4! You're doing brilliantly this week so keep it up! Lots of learning to be done today, so have a go at the active task and let's do this!


Today's active task: I LOVE this [song](#) and hope you do too. I'll definitely be dancing along later! Have fun! 😊


Maths Task
