

**Maths Task**


To begin, I would like you to Log in to Times Tables Rockstar's <https://trockstars.com/> and complete work on your times tables for 10 minutes.

What number is each number line showing?




Becky has partitioned 57 in six different ways.


$57 = 50 + 7$
