Good morning Language Class. It's Monday again and the start of another new week! Here are your activities for today.

English Task Please practise your phonics daily with Read Write Inc reading and spelling sessions on You Tube. Please try reading for 10-20 minutes each day.

This week we are going to be focusing on handwriting and practising letter formation of both lower and upper case letters. Today I would like you to practise some of the 'c' based letters i.e. 'c, a, o, q, d' using the worksheets attached. Remember to start each letter at the top and don't take your pencil off until you have completed that letter. Try both the upper case (capital letter) and the lower case letter for these sounds. Pupils needing support with dyslexia, please use the specific handwriting sheets attached (you start forming letters at a different place as cursive handwriting is recommended). Do you know both the name and the sound these letters make? Say the letter name and sound as you write it. Now try writing a sentence(s) (maybe using your new spelling words) focus on forming each of the 'c' based letters correctly, that you have practised today.

Maths Task Today Y2's/ Y4's please start by practising your timestables on www.trockstars.com. YR's/ Y1's please practise writing your numbers correctly. Start 0-50 and then try 0-100.

This week we are looking at measurement again but thinking about capacity. Talk to a grown up. What is capacity? (the space inside a container). What would we use to measure capacity (e.g. cups, jugs or a standard measure like litres/millilitres etc.) As a recap of measuring capacity please watch 'Comparing Capacities' https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=EN_z-uUm1Ww Then please find two containers and compare them. Which holds more? Which holds less? Repeat this 5 times with different containers. Can you record this using pictures and the signs > (more than) and < (less than) e.g. the bucket > the plant pot. Try comparing 3/4/5 containers and recording this for a challenge!

Foundation Subject Task Today, I would like you to take part in the final photography competition: Capture a Moment. There are prizes by age group for winning entries, and the winning entries will also be published in our Central RSA Academies Trust magazine, DesignEd, in a special 'lockdown' edition. A photograph allows you to instantly capture a moment in time. Over the week, try to capture a poignant moment in time.
