English Task

Today we would like you to be phoneme finders!
 Play this game;

 Select the sounds ow, oa and then o-e. Can you find all the words in the word search? When you are finished, write all the words you find in a list. Think about your handwriting as you write them; small letters need to sit on the line, make sure the tall letters are tall!. The letters f, g, j, p, q, y are on the line and go under the line too.



Maths Task

For Maths today we would like you to focus on subtracting number quickly;
 First try out this game <https://www.topmarks.co.uk/subtraction/subtraction-to-10>
 After this roll the dice and take that number away from the number 7.
 Write it down for example; 7-4= 3. Continue using the number 7. You can time yourself and see how many you can write and work out in 2 minutes!
 Then try taking away from the number 8 and then 9.

Foundation Subject Task

As we will miss the Olympic Games this summer and our very own sports day, this week we would like you to have a go at recreating some sporting events. Today we would like you to watch a clip of the opening ceremony in London 2012. Can you spot the torch?
