To begin, I would like you to Log in to Times Tables Rockstar's <https://trockstars.com/> and complete work on your times tables for 10 minutes.

If

$$\triangle + \triangle = 12$$

$$\heartsuit + \triangle = 19$$

What is the value of \heartsuit ?

One half of a number is 6
What is double the number?

Work out the value of each symbol.

$$\triangle + \triangle = 18$$

$$\triangle + \diamond = 30$$

$$\star - \diamond = 10$$
