In the video below, Alison chooses some three-digit numbers and carries out some calculations which lead to a surprising result!

Watch the video. What do you notice? Can you figure out the steps that Alison carries out in each calculation? If you can't access the video the following will help show you what you have to do.

Pick any three digit number.
Reverse the digits, so write your number back to front.
Subtract the smaller of your two numbers from the larger one.
Now reverse the digits of the answer you get.
Add the answer to its reverse.

Foundation Task

Today, using the attached game board, I would like you to get moving by playing a game of 'active monopoly'. All you need is the die that was in your learning packs and two items you could use as counters. Work your way round the board and complete the challenges you land on. Have fun!
