English Task

For today's task, we would like you to look very carefully at Puffy. Can you think of some describing words to describe what he looks like? Think about what size, shape and colour he is. Try and put your describing words into a sentence.

For example; you could write 'Pufee is spikee and orinj.' Try and remember to 'Fred-talk' each word and also use finger spaces and a full stop at the end.



Maths Task

For today's task we are going to do some taking away by using our fingers.

- Using the dice in your home learning pack, roll it twice and write down each number on your whiteboard.
- Now putting the **largest** number first write the number in a subtraction number sentence. For example if you rolled a 3 and a 1 you would write '3 - 1 ='
- Now looking at the largest number, show that many fingers. So I would show 3 fingers.
- Looking at the smaller number, hide that many fingers. I would then hide 1 of my 3 fingers.
- How many fingers do you have left? I have 2 fingers left showing! Write it on the end of your number sentence. So I would write '3 - 1 = 2'.
- See if you can complete 3 more subtraction number sentences using your fingers to help you.

Foundation Subject Task

Today we have set a task for you to complete over the summer holidays. We would like you to have a go at completing some of the pages in your new journals. It could be photographs of things you have done, pictures of things you have seen on a walk or maybe you might want to make a picture of something you would like to see. It is completely up to you, you choose! When you return to school, we will ask you to bring in your journals to share them with one another. Mrs Digger can't wait to see what you have done.
