


If you are collecting from **both key stages** please arrive **from 3.15pm** to stop the need for waiting on site.

Home Learning (Years 1-6) will be a in paper pack format this half term and will be coming home today. They are due back on Tuesday 20th October.

Please can any library books that were borrowed during lockdown be returned, along with the class novels that years 4, 5 and 6 may still have at home.



Gold Zone lunch will still continue at the end of each half term. Miss Crawley will have a gold zone lunch with each hub (class) separately over the course of the final week each half term.



Sparks certificates, house-point certificates and attendance awards will still be handed out in class each week.
