What Makes Us Super?

Rationale: Through this flexible theme we will learn about each other and what makes us unique. We will develop our oral communication skills through discussions, questioning and reasoning and hope to foster a love of reading through sharing and retelling stories and role playing with others. We will learn about the rules at school, how to keep ourselves safe and how to be a good friend.

Literacy

We will be sharing the story of 'Supertato' and using it as a discussion point about how we are all 'Super'. We will discuss the other characters in the story and how they help their friends. We will practise how to write our names using the Read, Write Inc. Letter formation rhymes. We will begin to learn individual letter sounds and have a go at writing them.

Understanding of the World

We will be sharing photographs of ourselves as babies and looking at how we have changed over time. We will learn which foods are healthy and unhealthy and have a go at naming and sorting some fruits and vegetables.

Physical Development

Our first challenge in our PE sessions will be to get dressed into our PE kits as independently as we can! We will then practise skills such as running, skipping and hopping. The children will also be developing their gross motor skills through our 'Write Dance' activities which focus on large movements to music with our hands, arms and legs. We will be developing our fine motor skills by using scissors to cut out shapes and tweezers to pick up buttons and pom poms.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

We will share experiences and memories about ourselves, discussing our likes and dislikes. We will encourage the children to talk about their family and to look at how they have grown and changed since birth. We will be encouraging everyone to make lots of new friends!

Maths

This half term we will count different objects up to 10 and beyond. We will have a go at matching the correct number of objects to the correct numeral. We will also be looking at numbers in our environment, what they are for and why they are there, e.g. on houses, on birthday cards or on buses.

Communication and Language

Talking about ourselves will hopefully come naturally as we share all of our exciting stories about ourselves and what makes us special. We will be encouraging the children to talk about what makes them 'Super' and how they are unique.

KASE

Our curriculum is designed to ensure the children build their knowledge whilst having opportunities to develop important attributes like teamwork and empathy. We plan for a clear progression of skills and provide a wealth of experiences to further their engagement and understanding. We therefore call this our KASE curriculum.

Expressive Arts and Design

We will paint self-portraits and create a class gallery with our masterpieces. We will also create our own 'Supertato' models when exploring fruits and vegetables.
