



# Sutton Park Primary RSA Academy

## Curriculum Map Year 1

### Autumn 1 2020

PE will be on Monday and Wednesday. Please make sure all items of clothes are clearly named. We have Forest School sessions on Tuesday and Thursday afternoons.



Rationale -We have chosen this topic as it focuses on our senses. By using all their senses, the children will be able to create a greater bank of vocabulary to support them with writing more exciting sentences.

#### Maths

In Maths we will count to and across 100, forwards and backwards, beginning with 0 or 1, or from any given number. We will practise counting in 2s, 5s and 10s. We will also be looking at measures to compare, describe & solve practical problems for lengths and use words like; long, short, longer, shorter, double and half. Then we will order up to five objects by length. As a class we will use objects to help us to add and subtract and use + - and = signs to record our calculations.

#### Science

In Science we will name, draw and label basic body parts and look at the skeleton. We will also learn about our 5 senses through activities like listening walks, tasting sessions and feely bags. The class will be thinking about healthy living and hygiene and will investigate the spread of germs.

#### Art/ Design Technology

In our DT sessions we are going to design and make our own motif to add to a whole school project on 'Belonging'. To do this we will be exploring the process of Tie-Dye. We will be tasting a range of fruits and selecting our favourite. From this we will design and make our very own fruit smoothie.

#### English

The class will be reading 'Handa's Surprise' by Eileen Browne and we will focus on writing each letter sound in the order that we can hear them. We will also be using adjectives to make our writing more interesting. After this we will move on to reading 'Peace at Last' by Jill Murphy and we will be writing setting descriptions using each of our senses.

Year One will also have daily Read Write Inc sessions to consolidate our knowledge of sounds and learn new sounds.

## How do our bodies work?

#### PE

In outdoor PE we will be playing games to help us to aim and throw at a target. We will talk about the importance of exercise to keep our bodies healthy and the effects that exercise has on our bodies.

#### Music

The class will be exploring African music to link with our story, Handa's surprise. We will also have a go at making our own African musical instruments. Linking to our story 'Peace at Last' the class will be using instruments to make sounds we hear around the house.

#### Computing

We will be exploring ways a computer program presents data and we will be gathering our own information adding it to a pictogram showing for example; 'Favourite fruit in Year 1'.

#### PSHE/ Thrive

In our Thrive sessions we will learn about our emotions and how to address and deal with a range of emotions. We will also think about how to keep ourselves healthy and active and how that makes us feel.

#### RE

In RE we will be learning about the story of Creation and how the world began according the bible.

**KASE** Our curriculum is designed to ensure the children build their knowledge whilst having opportunities to develop important attributes like teamwork and empathy. We plan for a clear progression of skills and provide a wealth of experiences to further their engagement and understanding. We therefore call this our **KASE** curriculum.
