Little Sparks Curriculum Map - Autumn 2

How Do We Celebrate?



Rationale: Through this topic we will be sharing how we celebrate different traditions and festivals in order to help us talk about significant events from our own experiences.

Literacy

The children will continue to participate in phonics games to identify different sounds, match words that rhyme and find words that start with the same sound. We will also be clapping the syllables in key words and our names. The children will be asked to talk about the marks they make, particularly when they 'write' their letters to Father Christmas.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

We will continue our circle time sessions and begin by talking about things that are special to us. We will be celebrating each other's achievements from home, by 'sharing the chair' when reading out WOW! certificates. We will be taking turns to complete a special scrap book all about ourselves, to then share with our Nursery friends. We will also be discussing the importance of staying safe on Bonfire Night and finally about why people may give gifts at Christmas.

Physical Development

This half term the children will be continuing to develop their gross and fine motor skills by making large shapes with their arms in PE and through mark making activities in Nursery. We will continue to develop our listening skills to move our bodies in different ways and avoid obstacles.

Maths

The children will have many opportunities to engage in Maths activities both inside and out. We will be finding the total by counting all of the objects, practising number recognition and naming shapes. We will be practising sharing different values, by sharing pretend fruit onto plates for animals and our friends.

Expressive Arts and Design

The children will be able to enjoy many creative activities including making firework pictures, shape rockets and Christmas cards. They will also explore imaginative role play with our Nursery Hospital, Santa's Workshop and Post Office.

Communication and Language

We will focus on developing the children's expressive language which will look at what they say and how they link words together. We will encourage them to use talk to connect ideas, explain what is happening, anticipate what might happen next and recall past experiences. The children will also ask each other questions about the special weekly scrap book that their friends share with them each week.

KASE

Our curriculum is designed to ensure the children build their knowledge whilst having opportunities to develop important attributes like teamwork and empathy. We plan for a clear progression of skills and provide a wealth of experiences to further their engagement and understanding. We therefore call this our KASE curriculum.
