

Sutton Park Primary RSA Academy Curriculum Map Year 1

Spring 1 2022

What can I find in the UK?

PE will be on Monday and Friday. Please make sure all items of clothes are clearly named.

We have Forest School on Fridays.

Rationale: This topic builds on the children's knowledge and understanding of the world around us. By exploring the United Kingdom, it will support the children's descriptive writing and introduce them to a wider range of geographical language.

RE

In RE we will be learning about who is God and what do Christians believe he is like.

Art

During our Art sessions, we will be exploring the work of Pablo Picasso. We will be mixing primary colours to create secondary colours and use the colours to represent some of Picasso's abstract pieces of artwork.

Science

To become scientists, we will be identifying a variety of common animals including fish, mammals, amphibians, birds and reptiles. Year One will also be describing the characteristics and structure of animals focussing on penguins. During our Forest School sessions, we will be looking for and naming various types of birds whilst thinking how we can help them during Winter.

Maths

In Maths we will be learning about time, sequencing events and use language such as today, tomorrow and yesterday. We will identify one more and one less of a number to 100. The class will then be measuring mass and weight and will look at kilograms and grams. We will consolidate our understanding of 2D shapes and describe and sort the properties of triangles, squares, circles and rectangles. We will continue to practise our number bonds to 20 and doubling and halving numbers.

English

'Katie in London' by James Mayhew will be the text we use to inspire our writing. We will be writing postcards from Katie describing the landmarks that she saw in London. We will sequence the story and create a class story map to help us to re-tell the story. Also, we will change the story by introducing a new character. We will explore similes and correctly adding -ing or -ed to the end of verbs. We will also continue to extend our sentences with words like 'and, or, because'. As a class we will focus on forming our letters and writing the descenders and ascenders correctly. We will continue with daily Read Write Inc sessions to consolidate our knowledge of sounds and learn new sounds.

Geography

To help us to become geographers, we will be using atlases and maps and naming the seas and countries of the UK. We will also be thinking about the similarities and differences between London and Kidderminster.

PSHE / Thrive

During our PSHE sessions we will be learning how to keep ourselves safe and how to manage risks. We will explore our own personal safety as well as keeping safe online when using devices and when outside our homes.

PE. Our fundamental skills will be developed by sending and receiving balls and improving our passing technique in football. This half term we will explore traditional English dancing by looking at Morris dancers and how they move to create a whole class dance, which we will later perform at a virtual dance festival.

Music

To improve our skills as musicians we will listen to a range of live and recorded music from around the UK. We will also use percussion instruments to play along with traditional music.

Computing The class will use Google maps to help name the seas and countries of the UK. We will also link with our PSHE to learn how to keep ourselves safe online with E-safety.

KASE Our curriculum is designed to ensure the children build their knowledge whilst having opportunities to develop important attributes like teamwork and empathy. We plan for a clear progression of skills and provide a wealth of experiences to further their engagement and understanding. We therefore call this our **KASE** curriculum.
