



Sutton Park Primary RSA Academy Reception Curriculum Map Summer Term One 2022



Why and how do things grow and change?

Rationale: We are using key stories to develop the children's understanding of growth and change in the natural world. Through this flexible theme the children will have the opportunity to plant, observe, predict and evaluate changes in plants and animals. We will have many opportunities for discussion, for the learning of key vocabulary and for scientific enquiry.

Literacy

We will be focusing on our writing and learning about capital letters and full stops. We will be having a go at writing simple sentences while some of us will be continuing to learn how to use our fingers to count out how many sounds we can hear in a word before we attempt to write it. We will also begin daily handwriting practice so please be punctual in the morning! The children will continue with daily Phonics sessions and weekly Guided Reading.

Understanding of the World

We will be learning more about caterpillars as we care for our own live ones and try and keep them safe so that they can transform into butterflies. We will also be planting seeds and learning what plants need to grow. We will discuss where our food comes from, how and where it is grown and how it is made. We will conduct experiments such as growing cress in different places.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

Our theme will allow the children to care for living things and learn how to help plants and animals thrive. We will discuss what we need to keep us happy and healthy and what we can do if we don't feel like we are thriving. We will discuss healthy eating and recap good oral hygiene and sensible screen time. We will make our own fruit salad and encourage the children to try new and unusual fruits.

Physical Development

We are going to continue practising our small motor skills and really focus on correct letter formation. In PE we will be using a range of large and small apparatus to develop our body strength, coordination and balance. We will also be engaging in team games and races.

Maths

We will continue to explore odd and even numbers and how some quantities can be shared equally. We will also look at double facts to 10 and subtraction facts too. We will practice our recall of number bonds to 5 and 10 and explore pattern and symmetry.

Communication and Language

We will have lots of opportunities to listen to and join in with stories. We will be testing our ideas, predicting changes and evaluating what happened during our learning about plants and animals. We will continue to ask questions to find out more and to check our understanding. We will encourage the children to use their spoken language to solve problems and organise their thinking.

Expressive Arts and Design

We will be making bird and butterfly feeders for Forest School. We will discuss the design for our butterfly feeders, make the feeders and then evaluate how successful they were and what we might change next time.

KASE Our curriculum is designed to ensure the children build their knowledge whilst having opportunities to develop important attributes like teamwork and empathy. We plan for a clear progression of skills and provide a wealth of experiences to further their engagement and understanding. We therefore call this our **KASE** curriculum.
