



Sutton Park Primary RSA Academy Reception Curriculum Map Summer Term Two 2022



What could be under the sea in different parts of the world?

Rationale: We are using the topic of 'Under the Sea' to explore further our interest in animals, water play and vehicles. Through this flexible theme the children will be able to learn about different habitats and climates; where in the world different creatures are found; how the British seaside has changed over the years as well as becoming more curious about their immediate environment and the wider world.

Literacy

We will share stories such as 'The Rainbow Fish', 'Barry the Fish with Fingers' and 'Sharing a Shell' to name just a few. We will explore the characters, settings and key events and think of how we can guess or change the story endings. Most of us will now focus on writing sentences and we will all be trying to write the sounds we can hear in words. We will continue our 'Guided Reading' groups and 1:1 reading.

Understanding of the World

We will be learning about things that we find under the sea and which animals are found in different oceans around the world. We will make comparisons between our own sea life and that of other countries and think about ourselves and what makes us different and unique. We will discuss questions such as 'could we live under water?' and encourage questioning and explanations from the children. We will also look at the seaside in the past and present day.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

We will be using the events and scenarios in our stories to explore our own feelings. We will focus specifically on sharing and saying kind words and how this makes us feel. We will encourage the children to think about how they would feel if they were the story characters. We will also be discussing how to resolve conflicts and how we can learn to negotiate with each other by listening to each other's ideas.

Physical Development

We will discuss the importance of keeping active and the effects of exercise on our bodies. We will continue to practise ball skills in PE such as rolling, kicking, aiming and throwing. We will also practice our sports day games. We will also be working hard with our letter formation when writing. Please practise this together at home.

Maths

This half term we will be continuing to explore number bonds to 5 and 10, the aim being that the children can automatically recall these. We will also look at the corresponding subtraction facts. We explore and represent patterns within numbers to 10 such as odds and evens, doubles and how quantities can be shared equally.

Communication and Language

We will have lots of opportunities to listen to, join in with and answer questions about stories. We also need to be able to ask and answer *how* and *why* questions about our experiences in response to stories. We will have key vocabulary linked to under the sea and the seaside and really focus on the meaning of different words and where we might have heard them before.

Expressive Arts and Design

We will have the opportunity to use different materials and media to create sea creatures and under the sea collages. We will have different role play areas, including an aquarium, to allow the children opportunities for imaginative play.

KASE Our curriculum is designed to ensure the children build their knowledge whilst having opportunities to develop important attributes like teamwork and empathy. We plan for a clear progression of skills and provide a wealth of experiences to further their engagement and understanding. We therefore call this our **KASE** curriculum.
