

Sutton Park Primary School Sparks Curriculum Map - Autumn; What make us unique?



Rationale: Through this topic we will be finding out all about ourselves, exploring our similarities and differences. This will give us the opportunity to develop our communication and language skills by talking about our likes and dislikes such as food, as well as listening to

Literacy

We will be playing phonics games to help develop the children's ability to identify different sounds e.g. instruments or sounds in the home.

others and responding to them.

The children will be encouraged to talk about the stories we share and to make links with their families and experiences.

We will be exploring a range of stories and talking about key characters. We hope you

Physical Development

The children will explore different music and be encouraged to move rhythmically, developing awareness of how it changes our mood and the movements we make. We will be playing games to keep them active and to improve key skills such as throwing, running and jumping. The Nursery environment will be set up with many opportunities to mark make inside and outside. Children will be encouraged to develop their gross and fine motor skills through large scale painting and using tweezers to pick up objects.

Understanding of the World

The children will have the opportunity to explore the Sensory Garden. They will be asked to observe any sounds and changes in the areas, particularly linked to the changing seasons. We will be discussing different types of homes and who lives with us to help understand our similarities and differences.

KASE

Our curriculum is designed to ensure the children build their knowledge whilst having opportunities to develop important attributes like teamwork and empathy. We plan for a clear progression of skills and provide a wealth of experiences to further their engagement and understanding. We therefore call this our KASE curriculum.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

We will talk about our new friends and learn their names and the children will be encouraged to learn or recap our Nursery rules. We will have circle time sessions where we will discuss our feelings and what makes us feel happy, sad, excited or scared. Later on in the topic we will learn about healthy eating and the importance of being active.

Maths

The children will be able to explore counting, sorting, colour recognition and patterns through our flexible theme. We will talk about our favourite foods, colours and stories, and make tally charts of our choices.

The children will learn different counting songs

The children will learn different counting songs such as 'Five Currant Buns' and will be encouraged to count how many friends are at Nursery each day.

Communication and Language

We will be focusing on developing the children's understanding of simple concepts such as big/little, same/different. They will be asked to name and sort familiar items in the home e.g. a kettle is found in the kitchen. We will be encouraging the children to develop confidence to share their ideas with one another.

Expressive Arts and Design

The children will be exploring colour and mixing colours. We will be talking about how colours change and the different ones we can see in our environment.
