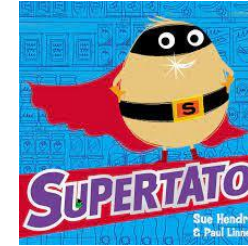
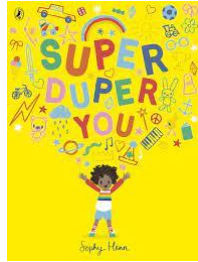

Reception - Autumn 1 2023

Super Me!



Rationale -We have chosen this topic as it focuses on ourselves and what makes us SUPER. We will be discussing our likes and dislikes and what are talents are through the use of Superhero texts. We will also explore healthy eating with Supertato!

Physical Development

Our first challenge in PE sessions will be to get dressed into our PE kits as independently as we can! If your child could practise getting dressed at home too that would help their independence. We will practise skills such as running, skipping & hopping. We will be developing our fine motor skills by exploring with play dough, tweezers, scissors and much more.

Understanding of the World

We will be sharing photographs of ourselves as babies and looking at how we have changed over time. We will learn which foods are healthy and unhealthy and have a go at naming and sorting some fruits and vegetables.

Maths

This half term we will count different objects up to 10 and then beyond. We will have a go at matching the correct number of objects to the correct numeral. We will also be looking at numbers in our environment, what they are for and why they are there, e.g. on houses, on birthday cards or on buses.

Literacy

We will be sharing the story of 'Supertato' and using it as a discussion point about how we are all 'Super'. We will discuss the other characters in the story and how they help their friends. We will practise how to write our names using the Read, Write Inc. letter formation rhymes. We will begin to learn individual letter sounds and have a go at writing them. We will send these home so you know which we are learning and when.

What makes you SUPER?

Communication and Language

Talking about ourselves will hopefully come naturally as we share our exciting stories about ourselves and what makes us special. We will be encouraging the children to talk about what makes them 'Super' and how they are unique.

Expressive Arts and Design

We will paint self-portraits to create a class gallery of masterpieces. Exploring with a variety of materials and tools will be lots of fun in our creative area this term.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

We will share experiences and memories about ourselves and discussing our likes and dislikes. We would like the children to talk about their family members, to look at how we have grown and changed since birth. We will be encouraging everyone to make lots of new friends!

KASE Our curriculum is designed to ensure the children build their knowledge whilst having opportunities to develop important attributes like teamwork and empathy. We plan for a clear progression of skills and provide a wealth of experiences to further their engagement and understanding. We therefore call this our **KASE** curriculum.
