# Extreme Earth 'How do volcanoes and earthquakes impact on humans?' 

## KANE

Our curriculum is designed to ensure the children build their knowledge whilst having opportunities to develop important attributes like teamwork and empathy. We plan for a clear progression of skills and provide a wealth of experiences to further their engagement and understanding. We therefore call this our KASE curriculum.

## Science

With links to geography and to become scientists, we will be continuing learning about rocks with a focus on soil and fossils.

## Geography

As Geographers, Year Three will be exploring the structure of the Earth. Through this they will learn about volcanoes and earthquakes ready to answer the question; How can we prepare ourselves from tectonic hazards? The class will also use maps to locate the 'Ring of Fire and explore the advantages and disadvantages of living near an active volcano.

NW:Madd las In English we will be reading 'Escape from Pompeii' by Christina Balt. We will be thinking about the key features of writing a setting description ready to write our own, which will feature a volcanic eruption! In our grammar sessions we will be learning to use adverbs to express the time, place, and cause and they will have 6 spellings to learn each week. Year Three will continue to focus on fluency with their reading and how to use the text extract to information.

## PSHE and Thrive.

In these sessions, we will be thinking about how we should make healthy choices and keeping active. We will also work together to agree a set of playtime rules.

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## Maths

In Mathematics pupils will continue to add and subtract up to 3 - digit numbers using the column method. We will write and calculate mathematical statements for known multiplications and division facts. Year Three will also be measuring the perimeter of 2 D shapes. After this we will interpret and present data using pictograms, bar graphs and tables. In our Mental maths sessions, we will focus on the 3and 4 -times tables.

## Music

Year Three will be listening to the composer 'Hans Simmer'. They will also explore rhythm and pulse through songs, rhymes, and chants. They look at the term; time signature and learn that music is written in bars.
