
PE will be on a Tuesday afternoon and Friday morning. Please make sure your child has their named PE kit in school.

Sutton Park Primary School Curriculum Map - Year 6 Summer 1 2024



With SATs on the horizon, Year Six will be busy revising in our Maths and English lessons. We will still be experiencing a broad and balanced curriculum as detailed below.

We will also finish reading our set text 'A Journey to the River Sea' and use this to write a diarv and persuasive letters in character.

English

In English, children will complete their adventure through the Amazon, where they will experience a variety of writing genres including:

Non – Chronological report. This will take the form of a cold task on the rainforest, and a hot task on an animal from the rainforest of their choice.

Diary and Letter writing in character.

Argument/debate – Problems of the rainforest. Children will be given roles that they must keep to whilst taking part in the written and oral debate.

<u>PE</u>

This term, we will play rounders and tennis.

We have also been lucky enough to secure some training from Kidderminster Harriers who will be delivering their Health Kick Programme to us. They will visit us on a Friday Morning.

Science

Pupils will become scientists by continuing to investigate living things and their habitats. This will include: Classification of living things, then moving on to;

- Cells and life systems
- Variation, adaptation, and evolution.
- Identify how plants have adapted to suit their environment over time.

Geography

Children will continue to look at important areas linked to the rainforest. These areas will provide several talking points and deep learning opportunities. These include:

The destruction of rainforest Comparison between life in Manaus/children's lives here. We will then move on to the topic of Settlements and study physical and economic reasons for trade links and settlements.

KASE

Our curriculum is designed to ensure the children build their knowledge whilst having opportunities to develop important attributes like teamwork and empathy. We plan for a clear progression of skills and provide a wealth of experiences to further their engagement and understanding. We therefore call this our KASE curriculum.

French

In French, through oracy, vocabulary and phonetic knowledge we will continue to learn about 'Items in daily life', as well as revisiting core basics such as numbers, colours and greetings.

Art and D&T

Children will be investigating paint and the effects that can be achieved when painting with watercolour. We will also look at the contemporary artist Terry Gilecki. In our D&T lessons we will be exploring mechanisms and experimenting with the movement of cams.

PSHE

This term children will investigate the risks associated with using different drugs, including tobacco and nicotine products, alcohol and identifying legal and illegal medicines.

Maths

After working so hard in the first two terms of the year, we now know we need to work on the following areas in the run up to our SATS:

- Angles.
- BIDMAS.
- Area and Perimeter
- Percentages.
- Algebra
- Ratio
- Multi step problems.

We will also continue to have arithmetic lessons, working on the four main operations and our times tables.

Computing

Pupils will continue to build upon their data handling skills including spreadsheets and the importance of formatting data to support calculations.

They will also begin to understand how they can be used to produce calculated data and where this may be used in real life situations.

<u>Music</u>

In Music, we will be continuing to explore film music and how soundtracks can be created using musical technology. We will investigate how to match mood, pitch and rhythm to suit the genre of film.
